



Reacher Nest Tool Holder

How to Use with a Ladder



Included Hardware:

2x Adhesive Rubber Strips

1X Alcohol Swab

4x Bolts

4x Nuts

1x Front Piece

1x Back Piece

Step 1. Determine if you want to attach to your ladder on horizontal or vertical tubing/posts.

Step 2. Determine if you will need 0, 1 or 2 of the rubber strips depending on thickness of the tube. 1" round will need 2 strips, 1.125 round may need 1 strip, 1.25" square needs no strips.

Step 3. Clean the area prior with the swab prior to attaching the self-sticking rubber strip.

Step 4. Apply the rubber-back adhesive strips so that the rubber side of the strips will make contact with the Tool Holder pieces when added to the ladder.

Step 5. Place the bolts through the back piece of the Tool Holder, and then place the back piece onto the ladder post against the rubber.

Step 6. Place the front piece of the Tool Holder opposite of the back piece; the bolts should go through both Tool Holder pieces.

Step 7. Place washers and nuts on each bolt.

Step 8. Tighten the nuts enough so the Tool Holder doesn't shift, but do not over tighten;

Warning: over-tightening the bolts could cause the Tool Holder to break.
